\*ICD-9-CM code V77.99 should be used as a secondary diagnosis with a primary diagnosis of primary hyperparathyroidism for patients undergoing parathyroidectomy with acute intraoperative monitoring of parathormone.

\*ICD-9 codes V67.09 and V77.99 should be reported for immediate post-operative follow-up after thyroidectomy and/or parathyroidectomy. The diagnosis representing the underlying condition responsible for the surgery should also be reported.
