### **MEDICARE LIMITATIONS AND GUIDELINES:**

Code 82270 is reported once for the testing of up to three separate specimens (comprising either one or two tests per specimen).

In patients who are taking non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drugs and have a history of gastrointestinal bleeding but no other signs, symptoms, or complaints associated with gastrointestinal blood loss, testing for occult blood may generally be appropriate no more than once every three months.

When testing is done for the purpose of screening for colorectal cancer in the absence of signs, symptoms, conditions, or complaints associated with gastrointestinal blood loss, HCPCS code G0107 (Colorectal cancer screening; fecal-occult blood test, 1-3 simultaneous determinations) should be used. Coverage of colorectal cancer screening is described in CMS Program Memorandum Transmittal No. AB-97-24(November, 1997).
