

PATIENT INFORMATION SHEET SEMEN POST VASECTOMY TESTING

COLLECTION INSTRUCTIONS

1. Patient should be instructed to collect a semen sample after at least 2 months post vasectomy and after 20 ejaculations.
2. Avoid all sexual activity, including masturbation, for 2-7 days prior to collection.
3. Collect Semen in a Non-Sterile Yellow Capped Container provided by physician. (Do Not Use Any container from home)
4. Semen specimen should be collected by masturbation.
5. The entire specimen **must** be collected into the container.
 - Condoms are not to be used for collection, unless provided by the physician.
 - Lubricants are not to be used during collection.
 - Oral stimulation or ‘withdrawal method’ is not to be used during collection.
6. Close lid tightly and Label container with Full Name, Date of Birth, Date and Time of Collection.
7. Keep specimen at room temperature. Avoiding extreme temperatures (hot or cold)
8. Deliver to a testing site below within 24 hours of collection.
