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Pediatric Urine Collection by Urinary Bag (U-Bag)

- 1. Separate the legs of the child.
- 2. Wash the perineum (area between the anus and the scrotum or vulva) with soap and water and dry well.
- 3. Do not use powder, oil, or lotion on the skin.
- 4. Remove the backing from the lower part of the adhesive patch
- 5. Remove folds in the child's skin by gently stretching the child's skin
- 6. Place the narrowest section of the adhesive against the perineum, ensuring that it sticks
- 7. Smooth the remaining adhesive against the skin, pressing firmly to avoid wrinkles
- 8. Remove the backing from the top part of the adhesive and smooth adhesive against the skin above the penis or the vagina
- 9. Frequently check the collection bag and remove once urine has collected in it.
- 10. Multiple attempts at collection may be required.
- 11. When the collection is complete, gently peel the adhesive back from the skin and drain urine into sterile container.
